Championship among juniors (14-15, 16-17 years old - boys and girls) ROMÂNIA, Reșița, 18 - 22th of August 2010

1. Classification of competitions

The competitions are classified individual and are held with the purpose to:

- identify of the strongest Unifight juniors;
- popularize Unifight as sport and expand it in Europe;
- consolidate international sports connections and experience exchange between National Federations.

2. Organization, timing and location of the competition

**Full and Light Unifight European Championship among juniors will be held
from the 18 - 22th of August 2010, ROMÂNIA, Reșița**

18th of August :

Referees seminar.

Teams arrival, quartering.

11:00 - 16:00 - Mandate Commission, weighing, casting lots of the Championship participants.

16:00 - 18:00 - official training in the zone of obstacles.

18:00 - 19:00 - joint meeting of Organize Committee, referees and teams representatives.

The joint meeting of Organizing Committee, referees and teams representatives is held in the end of each day of competition.

20:00 - Press conference.

19th of August :

10:00 - 10:30 - grand opening of Unifight European Championship among juniors.

10:30 - 13:30 - preliminary single combats of all the weight classes in Light Unifight.

15:30 - 18:30 - final single combats of all weight classes in Light Unifight.

15:30 - 17:30 - E.C.I.F.A.U. Congress.

20th of August :

10:30 - 13:30 - preliminary single combats of all the weight classes in Unifight.

15:30 - 18:30 - semi-final single combats of all the weight classes.

15:30 - 17:30 - Meeting between romanian officials and E.C.I.F.A.U. officials.

19:00 - 22:00 - Celebration dinner for 10 years of E.C.I.F.A.U

21th of August :

10:00 - 13:00 - final combats of all the weight classes in Unifight and awarding.

14:00 -15:00 - grand closing of Unifight European Championship among juniors.

3. Administration of the European Championship

General administration of the European Championship is part of the organizational committee.

The committee members are : M. Azer **GASANOV**- first vice-president F.I.A.U., M. Michail **BELENKIY**- member of E.C. E.C.I.F.A.U., M. Miroslav **JELINEK**- member of E.C. F.I.A.U., M. Andrey **KOLESNIK**- first vice-president E.C.I.F.A.U., M. Ivan **SHOPOV**- member of E.C. F.I.A.U., M. Audrius **SANTACKAS** and M. Marian **CONSTANTIN**- member of E.C. F.I.A.U.

Six European and 6 Romanian referees will participate. The European referees for European Championship service are called upon the decision of the E.C.I.F.A.U. referee board. The head of the referee board must conduct all discussions within the competition in French or English. Championship Refereeing is carried out according to the competitions Rules of Unifight, edition 2005.

4. Participants of the competitions

Team staff - youth/girls of 14-15, 16-17 years old :

Weight categories among boys:

14-15 years: 45kg, 50kg, 55 kg, 60kg, 65kg,70kg, 75kg, +75kg

16-17 years: 55kg, 60kg, 65kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 85kg, +85kg

Weight categories among girls:

14-15 years: 32kg, 37kg, 42 kg, 47kg, 52kg, +52kg

16-17 years: 37kg, 42 kg, 47kg, 52kg, 57kg, 62 kg, +62 kg

It is allowed to set 2 persons in each categories.

The National team consists of the chief of the team, 1 couch, 1 referee and other representatives.

5. Conditions for holding the Competition

The procedure for the draw and the order of contests shall be established by the Refereeing Commission (following Credentials Committee and the weigh-in) depending on the number of contestants in each weight category.

The Championship shall be held as a double event:

a/ Overcoming the Obstacle Course. Winning the obstacle course shall be regarded as one won round. The obstacle course shall include throwing a ball from the distance of 3 m through a hole in panel and an airgun shooting at the target (a toy balloon) from the distance of 10 m. Missing the target while throwing the ball or shooting shall be penalized by an additional passing of the obstacle preceding the firing and knife throwing line ("a tube" as a rule). Meanwhile, in case the opponent hits the target, the opponent shall be awarded in semi-light competition 1 point in the second round (separately for throwing and for firing).

The contestant having finished first the obstacle course with the time difference exceeding 10 seconds shall receive an additional bonus point, scored to him in the 2nd round. A bonus point shall be scored for each subsequent 5 seconds.

In case the time gap between the first contestant and the contestant having finished second is more than a half of the time the winner spent for overcoming the course, this contestant shall be removed from competition, and his opponent shall be awarded a clear win.

b/ Match on the tatami or the wrestling mat applying various fighting techniques.

The competition will be carried out according to the full and light universal fight rules.

On all stages of the competition (preliminary, semi-final and final contests), the contests on the tatami for male youth shall be 2 rounds, 2 minutes each; for female youth - 2 rounds of 1.5 min. each. Break between the rounds shall be 1 minute.

The competition shall be conducted according to the Olympic system in a single-elimination format.

In case of 3 or 4 contestants in a weight category, the competition in this weight category may be conducted in a round robin format.

In case there are 1-2 contestants in two consecutive weight categories, they may be united in a single category, the heavier weight category. This decision must be made and approved on the day before the draw by the minutes of the joint meeting of the Refereeing Committee of the Championship and the managers of the sports delegations of the member countries of the Championship.

Uniform of the sportsmen: kimono of red and blue colors, track suit and protective equipment - gloves, foots and helmet, mouthpiece, shin-pads, and shell.

Uniform of the referees: black trousers, white shirt with short sleeves, black bow-tie, black soft sports shoes, black socks, red-blue cuff.

6. The terms of arrangement and accommodation

Accommodation and meal (breakfast, dinner and supper) - 35 € per person.

The cost of transfer (from Timișoara or Arad airport to the place of competition) - 15 € per person.

The cost of transfer (Bucarest - the place of competitions) - 30 € per person.

The cost of stay should be paid by the representatives of the National teams to the Organizing Committee during the registration of delegation.

7. Financial conditions

The expenditures of trip, accommodation and meals, visa, free will charitable start fee, insurance police and official sport passports for participants - at the expense of National Federations.

The expenditures of prize fund, the rent of Sport Hall, the medals, diplomas, the payment for accommodation, meal and job for referees, accommodation and meal for the members of the Executive Committee of E.C.I.F.A.U. and the organizational committee - at the expense of the Organizing Committee.

The free will charitable start fee for involvement in competitions compounds - 25 € for each participant.

8. Winners identification

The winner of the final combat wins the first prize; the one who lost the final combat - the second; the ones who lost the semi-final combats get the third prize. Places of the other sportsmen are identified according to the round in which they finished the competitions.

In case the competition is held by following the circle system, the winner and prizes will be a raffle of the largest quantity of their victories, of the wined rounds, of the least quantity of the penalty etc.

9. Rewarding

Champions and prize-winners are rewarded with medals, diplomas and other prizes.

The participants who did not win at least one battle will not be rewarded by prizes.

All the commands must have two national flags and national anthem for the ceremony of awarding.

10. Applications

The present Statute is the call for the European Championship. The participants arrived after the call must provide the Mandate Commission through their representative or personally with the application in two copies, documents identifying their personality as well as the insurance policy for each sportsman. In order to get entrance visas to Romania in time foreign participants of the Championship must confirm their participation not later than the 15th of June 2010 indicating passport data (copies of the passports) of all the members of the delegation, place of work, position, work and home address.

The present statute is issued in English language.
